Dear parents and guardians,

During the current school building closures, students have been receiving supplemental learning materials from their teachers to facilitate a continuation of their usual school curriculum and instruction.

Amid the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Cuomo has directed the state's school buildings to remain closed for an additional two weeks through April 14. Given this new guidance from Governor Cuomo and the New York State Education Department, schools will continue to provide and support students with remote instruction during the previously scheduled Spring Recess. This is no longer a vacation.

Daily meals will also continue to be available to all children 18 years of age and under through this extended closure with the exception of Friday, April 10 (Good Friday).

We encourage all students to continue their learning while school buildings are closed, and for all families to stay home whenever possible. Providing continuity of learning and distribution of meals for our students remains a priority and should continue uninterrupted. ***Students should regularly check their student email accounts for any instructions or assignments from their teachers. Parents may contact their child's teacher for specific email log-in information as needed.***

**The school grounds are also closed for use until further notice out of respect for social distancing protocols. The track may be used for walking/running so long as social distancing practices are followed.**
