Dear Students and Parents of Our Senior Class:

With the extension of our school closure to May 15, I am contacting you with an update regarding the senior trip and prom.

For the safety of our students and staff and in order to provide families with the maximum possible refund, we are canceling the senior trip at this time. The prom is postponed, and we hope to reschedule this very important event for a later date. We have no new information regarding graduation at this time. We remain responsive to directives and guidance from our state and local officials, and we will update you as soon as we have any more information.

Please note the following with regard to refunds for the senior trip:

- If you paid the first payment with a check or cash, that amount has been refunded to you in an enclosed check.
- If you paid the second payment with cash, that amount has also been refunded to you in the enclosed check.
- If you paid the second payment with a check, your voided check is enclosed.

Any monies that had been raised through fundraising efforts and applied to a senior trip payment will be credited back to the student's class account and may be used to purchase Senior class related items such as prom tickets, or a yearbook.

I know that our seniors are hurting over this disruption and its effect on these once-in-a-lifetime events. I wish nothing more than for our students to be able to make these lasting memories. Please know that while we of course will keep their safety and that of others as our top priority, our goal remains to offer them the prom and graduation that they deserve. We miss our seniors, and we hope to be together again very soon.
