

SAUQUOIT VALLEY High School Supply List 2018-2019

It is the policy of Sauquoit Valley School District that certain supplies are considered pupil supplies that are essentially retained by the pupil and which are readily available from sources other than our School District. These supplies are as follows: pencils, (excluding any special testing pencils), pens, erasers, rulers, notebooks, (excluding workbooks which are considered textbooks), sneakers and other personal athletic needs, and index cards. **Listed below are supplies required by teachers in specific areas:**

English 9 – Pens and pencils, 3 ring binder stocked with plenty of loose leaf paper, highlighters and Posted Notes.

English 10 – Blue & black pens, pencils, spiral notebook for class notes, 3 ring binder, lined loose-leaf paper, folder to keep tests and other papers that are returned, posted notes & highlighters.

English 11 - Pens, loose-leaf paper, folders, composition & notebooks.

English AP 11- Pens, loose leaf paper & sturdy folders.

English 12, Dual Credit and AP Literature – Pens, highlighters, notebook, or binder with looseleaf.

AIS English – One spiral one-subject notebook, blue/black pens, one package 3 X 5 index cards, one pocket folder.

Global Studies 9 - Blue or black pens – NO RED OR NEON, & a two pocket folder.

Global Studies 10 - 3 inch 3 ring binder with dividers pens/pencils, highlighter & loose leaf paper.

AP European History – 3-inch 3-ring binder with dividers, loose leaf paper, highlighter & pens.

Dual Credit Government – 3 inch binder, loose leaf paper and pens

US History & Government - Blue or black pens – NO RED, 3” 3-ring binder with dividers, loose leaf paper & highlighters.

AP (Dual Credit) US History - Blue or black pens, 3 inch 3- ring binder with dividers, loose leaf paper and a highlighter.

50s, 60s, & 70s – 3-ring binder, loose leaf paper, & blue or black pens.

Economics/Government – Blue or black pens – NO RED, a two pocket folder.

Math - pencils, pens, loose leaf paper, 2” 3-ring binder, ruler, graph paper, Scientific calculator-Minimum required daily (or graphing calculator TI-83, is recommended but not required). Note: Cell phone calculators are NOT allowed in class.

Algebra/Pre-Algebra – In addition to Math supplies, 3 dividers and 1 pocket folder.

Accounting – Pencils, pocket folder, 2” binder, & calculator.

Personal Finance – Calculator and spiral notebook

Principle of Marketing – Spiral notebook

Spanish - Pens, lined notebook paper, notebooks, and 2 folders.

French – 2 different color pens, 2 different color highlighters, lined loose leaf paper, and a 2” OR 3” 3-ring binder.

Earth Science - notebook, pocket folders, 1” 3-ring binder, pens, pencils, 1 set of colored pencils, metric ruler, scientific calculator for Earth Science, Chemistry, and Physics that is to be brought to class daily.

Living Environment – Notebook, pocket folders, 1” 3 –ring binder, pens, pencils, 1-set of colored pencils, metric ruler & scientific calculator.

Chemistry – 3-ring binder, folder, pens, pencils & scientific calculator (not a graphing calculator, CELL PHONE CALCULATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED).

Physics – 2” 3-ring binder with pockets, loose-leaf paper, pens, pencils, metric ruler, protractor, scientific calculator to be brought everyday – cell phone calculators are not allowed.

AP Physics - 2” 3-ring binder with pockets, graph-ruled composition notebook, loose-leaf paper, pens, pencils, metric ruler, protractor, scientific calculator to be brought every day – cell phone calculators are not allowed..

Technology (All courses) – 1” 3-ring binder with dividers for each course, 1 package loose leaf paper, pencils, ruler, 2 pocket folders & headphones/earbuds for each course.

- 1” 3-Ring Binder OR Folder
- 1 package of paper plates
- 1 package of zip-top bags (any size)
